In Science we will be.....

Learning about animals, including humans, with a focus on the digestive system, teeth and food chains.

We will also learn about living things and their habitat, understanding how things can be grouped in a variety of ways and using classification to group and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment.

In Music this term we will be...

Working on our singing, focusing on songs with two/three part rounds.

We will also be developing our skills at playing by ear, using a range of tuned instruments.



In Computing this term we will be...

Learning to use Power Point and then produce our own presentation.

We will also be exploring different software such as Isle of Music and Scratch.





In Art and DT we will be...

Learning about Andy Warhol and using his work as a basis for our own painting.



Focusing on North America, we will be comparing geographical features, both human and physical with our local area.

We will also be improving our location knowledge, by learning to position a range of places on a map, including the Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere, Arctic and Antarctic circles and time zones.
