



In Science we will be....

Learning about evolution and inheritance, thinking about how fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the earth millions of years ago and why they may be different from living things on the earth now.

We will also be classifying and sorting living things based on their characteristics, this will include plants, animals and microorganisms.
