Our base camp for activities is situated in Eynesbury Primary School, PE19 2TD (on **Friday 23rd September** (3.30pm-5.00pm) and **Saturday 24th September** (10.30am -3.30pm) with adventures out.

... with an invitation to make a **DIY kit** or to collect the CCI playful tool kits to support your own creative mapping overnight, 3.15pm – 4.15pm, school hall.

And **Extraordinary Stories Walks** in the local area led by **St Neots Museum**, 4pm and 5pm, starting from the school (recommend to book in advance).

St Mary's Church is hosting an **exhibition** of work created by the children of Eynesbury Primary School for their *Fantastical Cambridgeshire* Project. Open Friday 3.30 – 5.30pm & Saturday 10.30am – 1pm.

The Blitz will be in full swing on Saturday 24th ...

... drop into school at any time during 10.30am – 3.30pm, to join in with a range of playful activities led by CCI artists and expert children including: **Map making stations, Wild Exchange cabinets, Sounds from all around and Fantastical Family Tours.**

St Neots Museum will have a *Mystery Object Table* full of unusual objects. Please bring others to share.

Saturday 24th includes a number of timed activities:

Extraordinary Stories Walks in the local area led by **St Neots Museum** 11am and 12 noon (recommend to book in advance).

Phantastic Philosophic Doodling with Neotist artist **Melina Lafirenze** – school playground, 11.30 – 12.30am & 1.30 – 2.30pm (join in between these times).

Found Mapping with Neotist artists **Clair and Richard Slade**, 11am – 2pm, Navigation Wharf (drop in).

Make a Fantastical Exploration Arkit with Neotist artist **Tracy Mowatt**, 9am – 1pm (drop in between these times) Interactive Art Stall at St Neots Market.
