94 parents responded to the OFSTED Parentview survey.

1. My child is happy at this school.

8. The school deals effectively with bullying.

Assuming approximately 63 parents made a response, 72% of parents who felt they knew the approach made by the school to dealing with bullying gave a positive response. <i>Building parent awareness and confidence in effective management of bullying will need to be an area of priority for the school as a result of this survey outcome.</i>

9. The school is well led and managed.
