



In Science we will be....

Continuing to look at seasonal changes, with a particular focus on winter.

We will also be exploring everyday materials, looking at what an item is made from, describing the properties of materials such as wood, plastic, glass, metal and comparing and grouping a range of items, based on their properties.



In Art and DT we will be...

Focusing on drawing and painting, exploring the use of lines, marks and curves as well as tone. We will also use ICT to create pictures using the artist Mondrian as inspiration.



In History and Geography we will be....



Looking at toys and how they have changed over time, this will include links with science, by exploring what items are made from.

We will also be looking at the Isle of Coll, using the Katie Morag series of books to help us learn more about the geographical features of a small Scottish island.

In Music this term we will be...

Using our voices creatively by singing songs and rhymes. We will also be listening to a range of high quality music and discussing what we hear to help us gain a deeper understanding of how the music is created and the effect it is intended to have on its audience.



Year One
Spring Term



In Phonics this term we will be...

Continuing to explore different graphemes that make the same sound. For example a long 'a' sound can be made with: a, ai, ay, a_e, ey.

We will also learn about the spelling patterns for plurals (adding s/es), and adding the suffixes ing, er and est.

In Computing this term we will be...

Using programmable toys to create and debug simple programmes and begin to use algorithms.



In PSHE this term we are thinking about..

Improving how we work together in work and play activities.



We will also be thinking about keeping ourselves safe; this will involve talking about household products, road safety and people who keep us safe.

In RE this term we will be...



Thinking about and exploring what it is like to belong to a Christian family. We will be thinking about why God and Jesus are so important to Christians and things that families may do or have in their home that show their faith.

In English this term we will be...

Continuing our work on traditional tales and working on information texts, this will be linked to our history topic of Toys .



We will also be focusing on the Katie Morag stories, linked to Geography and look at poetry with focus on pattern and rhyme.

In Maths this term we will be...

Working on time, place value up to 40, addition and subtraction, including problem solving using these operations.

We will also be learning about measures, multiplication, division and fractions.
