



In Science we will be....

Learning about animals including humans, focusing on their basic needs and healthy lifestyles.

We will be asking simple questions and answering them and identifying and classifying during our work on this topic.

We are also learning about different types of materials and their uses in everyday life.



In History and Geography we will be....



Learning about the Great Fire of London, comparing life now and then and looking at the Frost Fair in London. We will be developing our understanding of timelines, historical language and ways in which we can find out about the past.

We will also be learning about the geographical features of the UK including London, using compass direction, geographical language and maps.

In Art and DT we will be...

Looking at how colour, value and texture can be used in artwork. We will be looking at work by Van Gogh and using his work to inspire us. Jen Aryani will inspire our winter landscapes which we will work on with a partner.

We will also be designing and then making a product linked to our Great Fire of London topic.



In Music this term we will be...

Learning to play the violin. We will have a concert in November and demonstrate how we've learnt to read music, pluck and bow.

In Phonics this term we will be...

Looking at spelling patterns for words in the past and present tense. For example we will be

looking at what happens to verbs with two consonants at the end when you add ed, and adding 'ing' to verbs with an e at the end.

In Computing this term we will be...

Creating and debugging simple programmes and using logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programmes.

At home you can search 'coding for kids' in Google / app store to find free coding games and programmes such as 'Scratch' and 'Code Academy'.



In PSHE this term we are thinking about..



Healthy lifestyles, how our emotions can affect us and our responsibilities both in and out of school.

In PE we will be... Taking part in games lessons and later, performing dances using simple movement patterns.



In RE this term we will be...



Considering who Jesus was and his role as a teacher and leader. We will also be focusing on why Christmas is important to Christians.

In English this term we will be...

Reading and writing our own list poems. Later, we will write our own version of a traditional tale and finally, follow, give and write instructions. We will grow in confidence and learn to proof read, edit and read aloud our own work. We will

read everyday and shall be introduced to different genres and new authors. All of us will work hard on our spelling and handwriting each morning.



In Maths this term we will be...

Developing our love of maths and increasing our levels of confidence. We will start the year by investigating place value, using what we have learnt to solve problems. Alongside this we will be learning about money, how to count it to see how much we have and how to make a set amount. Later, we'll move onto addition and subtraction and learn some super strategies that can help us work with two, 2-digit numbers.
