



**In Science** we will be....

Learning about forces and magnets, making predictions about what might happen and learning about magnetic poles.

Then we will be focusing on animals including humans, focusing on the nutrition they need and learning about skeletons and muscles.

We will be asking scientific questions and finding the answers and using scientific evidence to answer questions.



**In Art and DT** we will be...

Looking at the work of impressionists including Cezanne and Monet, and focussing on pointillism. We will be improving our brush techniques and learning to create different textures and shapes.



**In History and Geography** we will be....

Learning all about Europe. We will be locating the countries of Europe on maps, looking at their key physical and human features and learning the location of the major cities.



**In Music** this term we will be...

Working on maintaining a steady beat or rhythm, playing pieces of music using symbols and playing on tuned percussion with increased confidence.
