



In Science we will be....

Learning about forces, in particular the effects of air resistance, friction and water resistance. Our focus scientist will be Isaac Newton.

We will also be looking at the properties and changing material, with a focus on the change between liquids, solids and gases and how these can be used to separate mixtures.



In Art and DT we will be...

Using our work on Egypt we will be designing, making and evaluating Egyptian masks.

In art we will be developing our skills in using clay including slabs, coils and slips.



In History we will be....



Learning about the Ancient Egyptians, this will involve work on chronology, map work, connections over time, and finding information from a range of reliable sources.

We will look at how and why pyramids were built and the process of mummification.

We will also be writing in hieroglyphics.

In Music this term we will be...

Improving our singing skills and knowledge, with a focus on songs with different parts.

We will also be learning about and using musical devices such as repetition, ostinatos, drones, combining musical phrases and effects.
