



In Science we will be....

Continuing to learn about the similarities and differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird. We will be describing sexual and asexual reproduction in some plants and animals, including humans. We will be exploring how humans change from young to old. We will also be exploring the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces, and identifying when forces are balanced and unbalanced and explain how this relates to the movement of objects.



In Art and DT we will be...

Exploring cooking and eating healthy meals and comparing our food to that of the Anglo-Saxons.

We will also be creating illuminated letters, and designing Anglo-Saxon jewellery.



Our artist study is Rousseau.

In History and Geography we will be....



Exploring Roman withdrawal from Britain, and Anglo-Saxon and Scot settlement including their invasion, kingdoms and rulers, art and culture, and Christian conversion.

We will also be studying the human and Physical geography of an area of the UK and Europe (where the Anglo-Saxons came from) and how it has changed over time. We will be exploring land-use and farming.

In Music this term we will be...

Playing music and improvising, using conventional and graphic notation to record simple rhythmic compositions .

We will also be finding and recognising relationships between lyrics and melodies.
